Find a morning where you can take time-off and come volunteer in the school with your child!

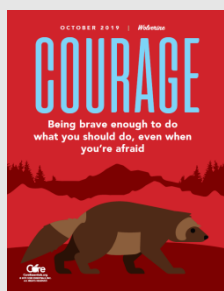

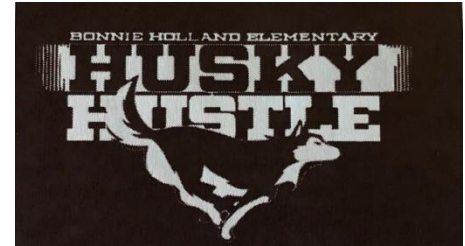

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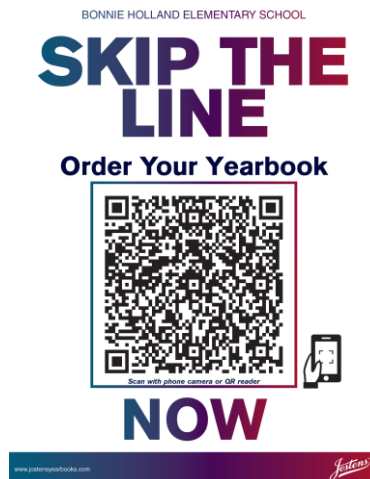

Legacy Parent Academy will continue in the 2019-2020 school year with sessions focusing on prevalent social- emotional topics. This year's sessions are as follows:

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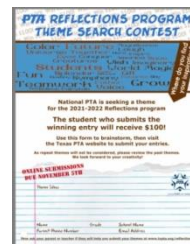
