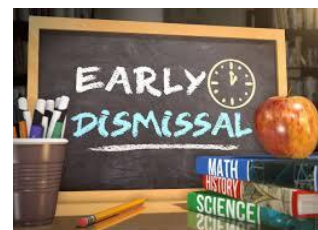

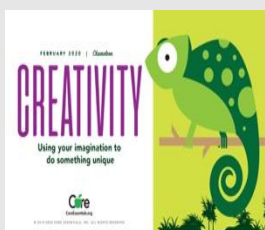

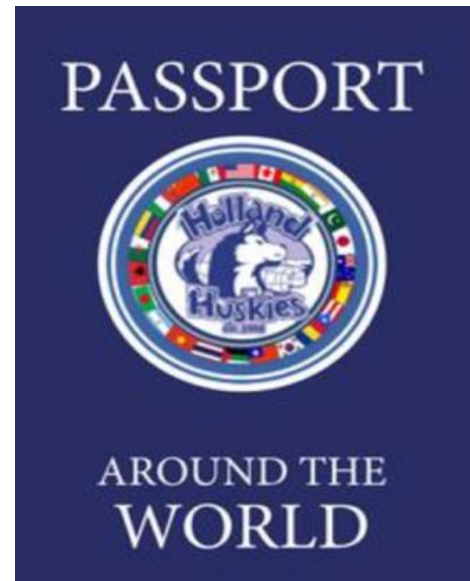

### Gifted and Talented Screening Updates

Parents, please take note of the current progress of GT screening at BHE.

- \*Fifth Grade screening is complete.
- \*Kindergarten screening is coming to a close and final placement notification letters will be mailed on **February 18<sup>th</sup>**.
- \*First through Fourth grade students are beginning the screening process and their notification letters will be mailed on **Friday, May 22**.

The screening process for each child is different. The proctor works with students in small groups, therefore not everyone is being tested at the same time. In some cases, we have all the information and data we need to make a final placement decision and no further testing is necessary. But please know that if your child needs a test, the proctor will send home a screening window notice. The screening process is a lengthy process and we greatly appreciate your patience.

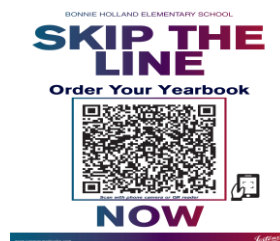
